1885 STATE OF IOWA CENSUS FORMS

Forms for recording the Iowa 1885 State Census have recently been made available at the I.G.S. Library. Forms save so much time and make neat readable records of census research. The sheets sell at 5¢ per sheet or in packages of 10 at 52¢ which includes the sales tax.
