## DID YOU KNOW?

In Wales, the prefix AP, denoting son, was generally used. Thus John, the son of Rice was John Aprice, abbreviated later to PRICE.

Our attention has been called to the fact that postal rates were increased Jan. 1, 1981 to foreign countries, or to any international address. Be sure to check with your postoffice before mailing. Do not send U.S. stamps or stamped envelopes for return mail as they can not use them. Send international reply coupons which they can redeem for their own stamps.

DANISH IMMIGRANT ARCHIVES, Grandview College, 1351 Grandview Ave., Des Moines, IA 50316, and the Danish American Heritage Society have undertaken a project known as Danish Immigrant Archival Lists. The aim is to aid researchers to know whether or not an item exists and where it may be examined. If you know the location of any Danish immigration material, would you please let them know.
