WARREN COUNTY, IOWA HISTORIES

Now and then we are told of an 1896 history of Warren County, Iowa. It happened again this month. It proved to be the 1896 MEMORIAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL RECORD OF IOWA. This book covers biographies of residents of central Iowa Counties. Some biographies of Warren County residents are included. We have this book in our local genealogical library.
