# State Conference Workshop

CENSUS State and Federal

lowa is fortunate to have many Census from which to search for your ancestors. Beginning with the 1836 Territorial census and ending with State census of 1925, it is a real help. Ask for a separate sheet of information about each census available.

A Few Tips:

1925 Iowa-(11) of the largest cities in Iowa have been indexed which helps tremendously. Also gives names of parents.

1915 IOWA-Names Alphabeticaly on 3x5 cards for each person. Puts families to-gether by consecitive numbers on upper left hand corner of cards. Gives birth place. father & mother.

1910 Federal-Gives birth placre of parents but has no Soundex.

1905 Federal-Not too helpful.

1900 Federal - Has Soundex. Look at microfilm. Has lots of good information. 1880 Federal - First Census to give birthplace of parents. Soundex available. Code index of families with children 10 yrs old or under in the household.

1870 Federal - The State Historical Library has received a NEW clear copy of the Federal Microfilm for Iowa. The old one was almost unreadable.

It is recommended by the experts that we should not rely on information from 1 census but look at our ancestor in several censuses to eliminate possible errors.

The State Historical Library has valuable source lists from the Polk Historical Book listing all adult males "Subject to Militia" for every ear from 1861 to 1910 in Iowa.
