BACKGROUND LETTER from new member Joseph HULL on the following two PEDIGREE CHARTS

The first pedigree or ancestor chart shows three previous generations back to my great grandparents, who represent 8 families; Hull, Harlan, Kelly, Green (paternal), and Dickson, Stoy, Brown and Waddell (maternal). My mother, Olive Dickson Hull, has done extensive research on her predecessors, and has just printed her first book, over 500 pages, titled "Family History of Steven Ward Brown, Including the Waddell, Sigafoose and Isherwood Families." She is currently working on a Dickson-Stoy volume. Some of the Browns and Waddells occupied Keokuk County in Iowa in the 1800's.

The Green and Kelly families on my father's side migrated from the Virginia shore into the Appalachian Mountains of westernmost Virginia and easternmost Kentucky in the early 1800's, before leapfrogging the country in the late 1800's to pioneer in Washington State. I have traced the Hull family and related branches (Cassidy, Alexander, etc.) back to central New York in the early 1800's; the Hulls were also Washington State pioneers.

The Harlan family is most relevant to Warren County, as can be seen from the pedigree chart for my great grandmother, Ruth Harlan. Most of the early Harlan familial relationships and vital statistics were first printed in Alpheus Harlan's 1914 monumental treatise, "History and Genealogy of the Harlan Family", containing over 27,000 Harlans and collaterals. I have supplemented and modified Alpheus Harlan's information with primary research of my own.

Moses Harlan, a Quaker, was the great great grandson of George Harlan, who came to Penn's Colony in 1687, serving as a provincial governor and member of the early Colonial Assembly. Lewis John Harlan was the youngest son of Moses and Ann Jennings, Moses' first wife. In 1854, Lewis John and his family moved to Belmont Township of Warren County, Iowa. I have done extensive research on Lewis John Harlan and his family, and hope to contribute more articles to the newsletter in the future. I am always interested in sharing and exchanging genealogical information.
