The Arrival of Settlers Lacona & White Breast Township 1840- 1890

The following entries have been abstracted from the <u>Lacona Chronology</u> compiled by John Ford and Edith Heemstra. The chronology shows events that took place in Lacona and White Breast Township from 1840- 1979. The chronology dates the arrival of only the earliest settlers of White Breast Township and the businessmen who have been prominent in Lacona's past.

The chronology contains much more information than what has been abstracted here. If any of the membership have ancestors from this area, I would be glad to search the chronology for their surnames. You may contact me, David Endres at 2450 Clara Bea Lane, Fairfield, OH 45014.

- * Note- The ages of the individuals at the time of the event are given immediately following their name.
- 1843- William WILLIS Sr. (28) and brother Martin (24) from Davis County, IA make a temporary settlement in White Breast Twp., are first settlers of twp.
- 1846- APRIL- William WILLIS Sr. (31), wife Mary (21), brother Martin (27), and Martin's wife Mary (20), move into Section 25, White Breast Twp., is first permanent settlement.
 - Anderson WILLIS (55), wife Sarah (55) and other six sons, Anderson (32), John (30), John's wife, Mary (27), Greenbury (26), Fielden (19), Robert (16), and Irvin (12) also settle in Section 25, White Breast Twp.
- 1853- E.G. BARTLETT (32) and wife Sarah (29) move into township.
- 1854- MAY- J.T. LACY (28) and wife Emily (27) buy several hundred acres one mile west of Lacona. Lacy was born in Durham, Canada of English ancestry. He was educated at the Hanover and Lebanon Liberal Institute in New Hampshire where he taught until becoming a lawyer. Emily was educated at Marietta College, Ohio. They moved from their farm to Indianola in 1875.
 - Willis CLEVENGER (35), wife Elizabeth (31) and their children from Indiana, settles where Lacona is located. CLEVENGER buys land north of Main St. Samuel MYERS (49) buys land south of Main St. in Lacona. They purchased the land from the government for \$1.25 an acre.
 - OCTOBER- Henry OXENRIDER (56), wife Margarett (44), son Sam (10), and other children settle 1/2 mile south of Lacona in log cabin.
- 1855- SPRING- W.J. COCHRAN (25) and brother, John M. COCHRAN (29) and his wife Mary (27) come in covered wagons. Also from Ohio come their Irish-born parents William (57) and Elizabeth COCHRAN (61). They settle 1 1/2 miles NE of Lacona. In 1856 the brothers open a general store in Lacona.
- John JOHNSTON (30) born in Scotland settles 1 1/3 miles north of Lacona.

 1856- SUMMER- Isaac C. SHUPE (24) and wife Nancy (20) move into White Breast Twp. Two years later the father Jacob J. SHUPE (52) and wife Cynthia (44) move into township.
- 1857- Peter RUBLE, blacksmith, moves to Lacona. In March 1858 sets up business in Lacona. In June 1863 sells it to blacksmith, John E. COOK.
- 1862- Dr. J.S. STARR (30) wife, Rosena (28) and two children move to Lacona and he sets up his practice. He would practice in Lacona for 49 years.
- 1863- MAY 7- Cash COLES (3) and mother Elizabeth move to Lacona.
- 1864- Dr. APPLEGATE moves to Lacona. Moves to Indianola in April 1875.
- 1865- DEC.- Joseph MCCOLLAM (37), attorney, sets up practice in Lacona. Serves community till November 1887 when he moves to National City, California.
- 1866- Dr. John MILLER (51) and wife Lucinda (42) move to Lacona. Practiced in Lacona until his death in November of 1893. At the time of his death he had a wife and seven children.
- 1868- Dr. S.W. NICOL (42), wife Anna (38) and family move to Lacona. In 1892 he moved to Indianola. He had served Lacona 24 years.
- 1872- SPRING- Dr. William H. PRESSLEY (58) and wife Sophia (57) move to Lacona. He dies in 1875 and she dies in 1897, both in Lacona.
- 1875- Dr. J.H. NICOL (26), recent graduate of Keokuk Medical School moves to Lacona. Serves Lacona until 1896 when he moves to Viscillia.
- 1876- JUNE 22- Chris KONRAD (22), blacksmith from Germany, moves to Lacona. In time he set up a blacksmith, carriage factory and a hardware store.
- 1880- James A. POGUE (27) and wife Anna (23) move to Lacona and open small drug store. In 1887 they begin to sell general merchandise.
- 1882- John W. STARR (24) the son of Dr. J.S. STARR, recent graduate of Keokuk College of Physicians and Surgeons, sets up drug store in Lacona. Remains in business until 1887 when he moves to Avery, loward control of the control of
- 1887- Frank FEHRER (31) arrives from Germany and begins smithing for Chris KONRAD. Frank would start = 5 own blacksmith business.
